A ROYAL PRIESTHOOD by Fr. Mike Schmitz (abbrev.)

Today is one of the largest feasts of the entire Church year: the Feast of Corpus Christi. This is the feast where we celebrate what happens on the altar.

In many ways, we weren't taught how to worship, and instead, we were taught the motions. So what do we believe? Jesus says, "This is my body. This is my blood." What we do at Mass matters because Holy Communion is not just a symbol. It is Jesus.

I invite you to make a difference in how you experience the Mass: embrace your priesthood. What does this mean? If you've been baptized, you're a kingdom priest. That means that when you go to Mass, you're not meant to watch. You are meant to offer the sacrifice with the priest and be involved in the mass, too. The idea behind it is we're all praying and worshipping together, both ministerial priests and kingdom priests. Switch from watching Mass to worshipping at Mass. Embrace your priesthood and use it! This means when a priest is at the altar, and offering up the sacrifice of Jesus, you are meant to be offering up your sacrifices as well.

"I am the living bread that came down from heaven, says the LORD; whoever eats this bread will live forever."

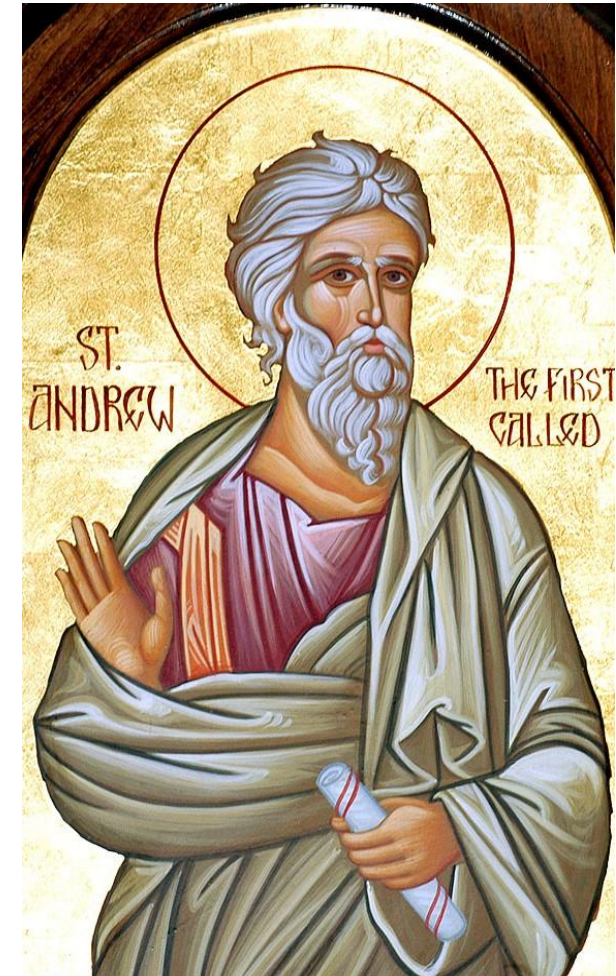
