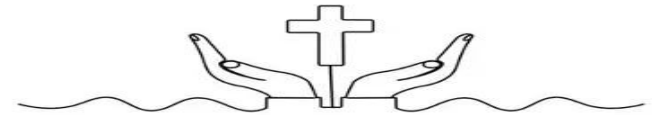

Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest." Mt 11:28

14th Sunday in Ordinary Time – Theme: Life in the Spirit (summary taken from talk by Jeff Cavins)

Saint Paul teaches in Romans 8 that to belong to Christ is to live **“not in the flesh, but in the Spirit.”** If the Spirit of God dwells in us, then His life is within us; if not, we remain trapped in the emptiness of the flesh. This Sunday invites us to be **constantly aware** of the question: *Am I living in the Spirit or in the flesh?* How can we tell? The **Gospel** gives us the way. In John’s Gospel, when Jesus calls His disciples to *follow Him*, he is offering more than a task—He is offering **companionship**, a shared life. A rabbi’s invitation meant: *Come be with me, stay close to me, learn my way of seeing, thinking, and living.* This is how Jesus teaches us to live in the Spirit. In Matthew 11, Jesus praises the Father for revealing divine truth not to the “wise and learned,” but to the **childlike**, the humble who are open to God. Only the Son knows the Father, and He reveals Him to those willing to receive His life. Then Jesus speaks the words our hearts long for: **“Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened... Take my yoke upon you.”** To take His yoke means to take **His worldview**, His will, His way of seeing everything: Marriage, Children, Love, Money, Judgment, Heaven and hell, the poor, the widow, the forgotten, the disenfranchised.

Living in the Spirit means asking daily: **Am I walking under the yoke of Jesus?** Do I see according to his worldview. **Am I living according to His plan, His priorities, His mercy?**

The way of Christ is kind and gentle. The needy place their faith in Him. And the path to freedom is not only resisting the flesh—it is **walking with Jesus**, doing what He commands, living as His disciple.

This week, we pray for the grace to **take His yoke and walk in it**, choosing the life of the Spirit over the life of the flesh. **God Bless.**

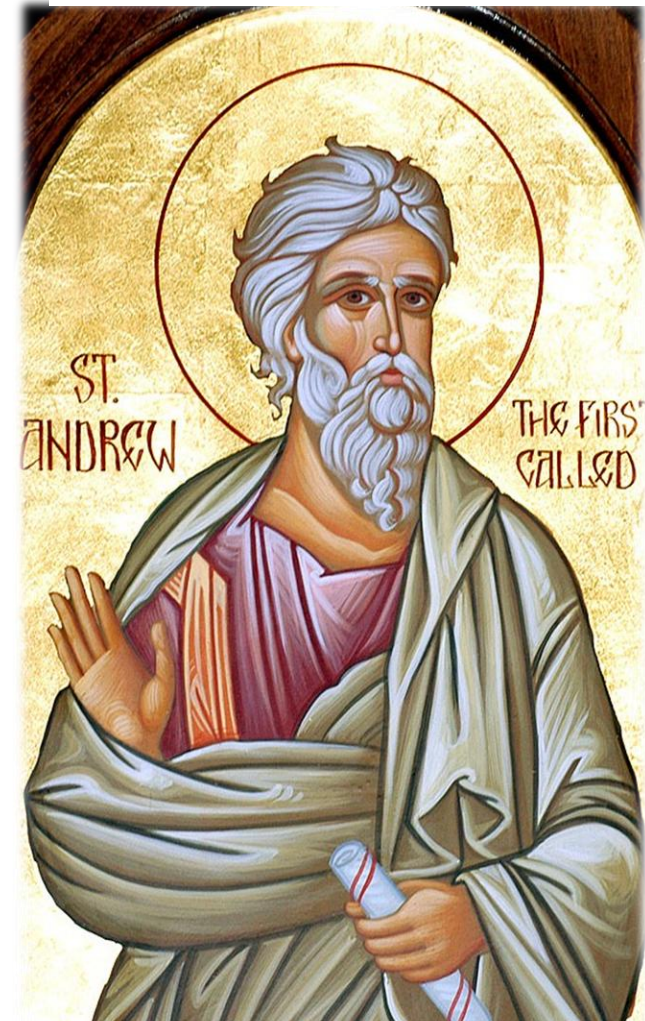
