Is 55:1-3, Ps 145, Romans 8:35, 37-39, Mt 14:13-21

The readings for the 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A show God's care for people and his free and unconditional love. God invites everyone to come and receive his gifts without cost. This shows that God's love is a gift, not something we earn. Jesus feeds the crowd, and Paul reminds us that nothing can separate us from Christ's love. God provides for his people's physical and spiritual needs and stays close to them.

Challenge: We are all called to respond to God's love and once we accept his grace, we must live according to his ways. Do I Trust God when needs seem greater than resources? Share what you have and care for those who are hungry or struggling.

Action Step: Small acts of mercy matter. Look for one person who needs help this week. Share your time, kindness, or resources with them. Surrender all your cares to God and let him take care of everything!
